## COVID-19: 10 POINTS TO REMEMBER IN A TEACHING SPACE

- 1. Remember to wash your hands with soap and water (or use sanitiser) regularly.
- 2. Staff and students do not have to wear a face covering in teaching space, unless a risk assessment requires it (see local signage).
- 3. Teaching spaces have allocated capacities displayed in each room. Advise students not to move the furniture, and to sit only in allocated spaces.
- 4. Wipe down your own area at the start and end of each session and advise students to do the same. Cleaning materials are available.
- 5. Ensure that windows are opened where signage requires it. There is already increased airflow in all our mechanically ventilated spaces.
- 6. Finish the session on time to help with the movement of people between teaching activities.
- 7. If anyone reports they are experiencing covid-19 symptoms, instruct them to return home immediately, self-isolate, book a PCR test, and follow Government and University guidance.
- 8. If the fire alarm sounds, leave the building immediately by the nearest exit. Meet at the assembly point and await further instructions.
- 9. If first aid is required, call University Security on **0113 343 32222**. For an ambulance call **999** then call University Security on **0113 343 32222** to direct it to you.
